Maintenance Metrics | Which KPIs Should You Track?

Process Performance Metrics, also called KPI's (Key Performance Indicators) focuses on how the task is being performed by measuring performance and if individual goals are being achieved. This indicator should be measured by a ratio (generally represented by a number) which portrays the progress of the process as a whole or in part.

8 examples of Business Process Performance Metrics

A cost-effectiveness ratio is the net cost divided by changes in health outcomes. Examples include cost per case of disease prevented or cost per death averted. However, if the net costs are negative (which means a more effective intervention is less costly), the results are reported as net cost savings.
