If the victim has no pulse, begin with 30 compressions to the lower half of the chest area near the bottom of the breastbone using one or both hands. The rate should only no less than 100 compressions per minute. Use a bag valve or pocket mask to open the victim's airway with 2 breaths.

If the victim has been in water or their chest is wet wipe the chest dry before attaching the AED. For adults compress to a depth of at least 2 inches but not deeper than 2.4 inches. For children compress $\frac{1}{3}$ the depth of the child's chest or about 2 inches.

Changes in BLS sequence from ABC (airway, breathing, chest compressions) to CAB (chest compressions, airway, breathing) for adults, children, and infants. This is because chest compressions were often delayed while rescuer opened airway, deliver mouth-to-mouth, retrieve barrier device, or gathered and assembled ventilation equipment.

GENERAL CONCEPTS. - Start compressions within 10 seconds of recognition of cardiac arrest. - Compression depth of 2 - 2.4 in. (5-6 cm.) for adults and children. - Compression depth of 1.5 in. (4 cm.) for infants. - Breathing rate is every 5 - 6 seconds (10 - 12 breaths per minute)
